Dear Parents/Guardians,

The following guidelines must be used for prescription medications to be given at school:

- 1. Any prescription medication, including Epi-pens and inhalers must come to school in its <u>original</u> container with student's name, correct dosage and time(s) to be given.
- 2. The <u>General Medication Form</u> must be <u>completed and signed by the doctor</u> to insure the correct dosage and time student is to receive any prescribed medication.
- 3. Each time dosage is adjusted or medication is changed a new **General Medication Form** must be completed and signed by the doctor.
- 4. <u>Attention Epi-pen and Inhaler users</u>: if the student is to self-carry his/her own Epi-pen or Inhaler please check <u>Self-Carry Authorization</u> box at the bottom of <u>General Medication Form</u>. *Please note those students who are self-carry are required to provide the clinic with an additional Epi-pen or Inhaler*.

This information is required to ensure the administration of medication to your student follows current doctor's orders.

<u>Please return authorization immediately so we are able to administer medications as ordered without interruption.</u>
