RE: Home School Assessment and Notification Forms

Attached is the form necessary for your child to be excused for the purpose of home schooling. During school years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021, House Bill 67 waived the requirement for the parent of student(s) who were homeschooled to provide an assessment report to the resident district. However, for the district to excuse attendance of a student to be homeschool in the 2022-2023 school year, an assessment report will need to be submitted with the paperwork for the 2021-2022 school year.

There are three options for reporting academic assessment:

- (1) An academic assessment report based on the results of nationally formed standardized achievement test. This assessment may be administered by a certified teacher or a person authorized by the publisher of the test; or
- (2) A written narrative by a certified teacher indicating that a portfolio of samples of the child's work has been reviewed and that the child's academic progress for the year is in accordance with the child's abilities; or
- (3) An alternative academic assessment report of the student's proficiency mutually agreed upon by the parent and the superintendent of the Millcreek-West Unity Local Schools.

If you intend to continue a home education program, please complete the form (or a letter outlining your educational plan) and return it along with an academic assessment (one of the above three options) for your children who were on a home education plan during the 2021-2022 school year.

We request that your Home Notification Plan and Assessment paperwork be submitted prior to the beginning of the district's first day of school (August 17, 2022). Until such time a compulsory attendance is excused for home education, school attendance is required.

If your children graduated or enrolled in another school setting, please note that anywhere on the Home Education Notification Form and return to us so that our records may be kept current. Thank You.

HOME EDUCATION NOTIFICATION FORM 3301-34-02 STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the rules in this chapter is to prescribe conditions governing the issuance of excuses from school attendance under section 3321.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, to provide for the consistent application thereof throughout the state by superintendents, and to safeguard the primary right of parents to provide the education for their child (ren). Home education must be in accordance with the law.

- **(B)** The academic assessment report shall include one of the following:
 - (1) Results of a nationally normed, standardized achievement test; or
 - (2) A written narrative prepared by a certified teacher or a person mutually agreed upon by the parents (s) and the superintendent, indicating that a portfolio of the child's work has been reviewed by that person and that the progress demonstrated for the year is in accordance with the child's abilities; or
 - (3) An alternative academic assessment mutually agreed upon by the parent and superintendent.
